Short Bio - Updated 5.2022

With her captivating voice and richly detailed songwriting, Sarah Jarosz has emerged as one of the most compelling musicians of her generation. A four-time Grammy Award-winner and ten-time nominee at the age of 30, the Texas native started singing as a young girl and became an accomplished multi-instrumentalist by her early teens. After releasing her full-length debut *Song Up in Her Head* at 18-years-old, she went on to deliver such critically lauded albums as *Follow Me Down*, *Build Me Up From Bones*, and *Undercurrent*, in addition to joining forces with Sara Watkins and Aoife O'Donovan to form the acclaimed folk trio I'm With Her. Her fifth studio album, *World On The Ground*, produced by John Leventhal, went on to win the Grammy award for Best Americana Album. In 2021 Jarosz released the Grammy-nominated *Blue Heron Suite*, a much-anticipated song cycle which she composed after being the recipient of the FreshGrass Composition Commission. She continues to tour in support of both releases.
